Registration & rules



Registration

All riders must enter through their National Federation; no individual entries will be accepted.

The 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup offers entry into the combined Under 23 category for Junior and Under 23 riders, or the Elite category for riders aged 19 or over. Registration deadlines are indicated in the General Race Parameters available on the UCI website ([2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup hub](#)) under the official documents.

Registration is via the UCI Reg-Online system, using the following link; [Sign In \(uci.ch\)](#)

The name and address of the hotel where the riders will stay must be given during the online registration.

The name and contact details (email and WhatsApp number) for each Team Manager must be provided during the online registration.

Entry payments

The entry fee for the 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup is **€150** for the Under 23 category and **€250** for the Elite category when using the online registration system. After the registration deadline the National Federation will receive an invoice by e-mail, sent by Papendal. There is the possibility to prepay the invoice or to pay on site cash (euros) or by credit card. In case of prepayment, the receipt should be taken to the Rider confirmation as proof of payment.

The entry fee must be paid for all entries not withdrawn before the online registration deadline, whether the rider(s) concerned are confirmed or not. For more information regarding prepayment please contact melissa.vandelft@papendal.nl.

Late registrations

Late registrations are entries handled **after** the online registration deadline and **before** the riders' confirmation deadline.

Late registration is only possible through the National Federation until the end of riders' confirmation on site which is on Thursday 11 June between 15.30 - 17.30. The entry fee for late registration is **€300** for Under 23 and **€500** for elite and must be paid immediately on site.

Rider confirmation

Riders confirmation is on Thursday 11 June 2026 between 15.30 - 17.30 at Hotel Papendal.

All Team Managers must attend the riders' confirmation, presenting the riders licences and picking up their race numbers. Riders not being confirmed before the indicated deadline above did not complete the registration procedure and will not be able to compete at the event. Riders that were registered through the online system but that are unable to participate will still need to pay their entry fee to the organiser. The registration office is located at Hotel Papendal.

Team Staff accreditation

All rainbow passes are delivered to the teams during the first event of the year. If additional sporting passes are necessary, the request needs to be sent before the event to norm.mccann@uci.ch. For the request, please indicate the reason, the name and the contact details of the person for whom the sporting passes are requested.

Passes will be distributed during riders' confirmation in the registration room.

Riders access

All riders are provided with a wristband so they can access the premises. The wristband gives the riders also access to the team and rider seating area.

Extra training days are available at Papendal. All participants of the 2026 UCI BMX Racing World Cup can participate.

Public transportation

Go to Arnhem Central Station by train. Then, take bus 105 (direction Barneveld) to bus stop 'West End/Papendal'. From that point, it is a 10-minute walk to Hotel Papendal.

From Monday to Friday, between 7 am and 6 pm (holidays excluded) it is also possible to take bus 10 (direction 'Sportcentrum Papendal'). This bus goes directly to our site. From the bus stop it is a 5-minute walk to the venue.

Papendal Taxi- **Taxi ABC**

We offer a 'Papendal taxi' which you can book at the reception of our hotel. The Papendal taxi runs between 7.00 and 24.00 from and to the Sonsbeek side of Arnhem central station. 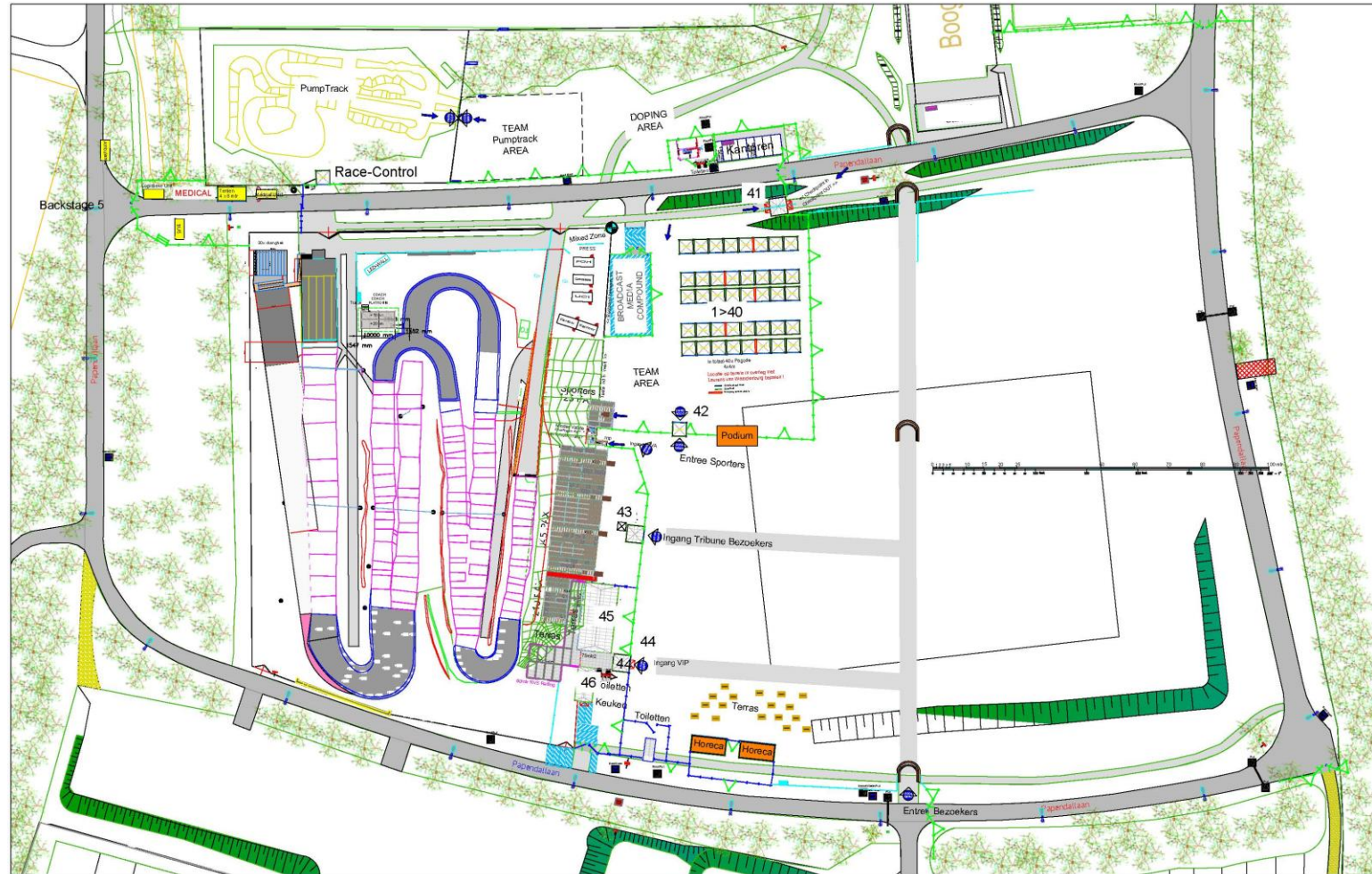

Team Bibs

Team Bibs will be provided for National Teams during the rider confirmation.

Teams will be asked to pay a **€100** deposit per bib.



The Team Bib gives access to allocated places explained by the PCP during the Team Managers meeting. The bibs need to be returned to the UCI Race Secretary at latest by the end of racing on Sunday 14 June. Upon return of the bib the deposit will be refunded at that time.

Team areas

The team areas are situated next to the track. Team areas are not accessible for cars. Cars need to be parked close to the team venue on the special Team parking area.

Parking

Parking for teams and riders is possible on the Team parking area. This parking is clearly indicated, and the car must show a parking card in the front window. You will receive the parking card at the riders conformation.

Team managers meeting

The Team Managers meeting will be held at 15.00 on Thursday, 14 June at Hotel Papendal. Please follow signage from the Hotel Reception to the meeting room.

Papendal BMX track

The Papendal BMX track will not be open for (non-event) practice during the event week. The BMX Track can be booked for practice up until Friday 5 June 2026. Team area tents

All teams can have a 4 x 4 metre tent (13,1' x 13,1') at their disposal in the team area. A table, chairs and power point are included.

A tent in the team area can be rented by teams for **€ 800,- (excl. VAT and service/ transaction costs)**. Also it is possible to rent more than one tent; they will be connected to create one large space.

PLEASE NOTE: At the Team Area, located close to the start hill, there is room for 40 team tents. Spaces will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please note that bookings cannot be cancelled.

Team Areas will be accessible from Friday 12 June 09:00 to Sunday 14 June 17:00.

The **drop-off** and the unloading of team equipment can only be on Thursday 11 June from 15:00 to 17:00 (vehicles permitted) and Friday 12 June from 09:00 to 10:00 (vehicles not permitted).

Equipment removal can be done on Sunday 14 June from 17:00. Every tent must be cleared out by teams before 19:00.

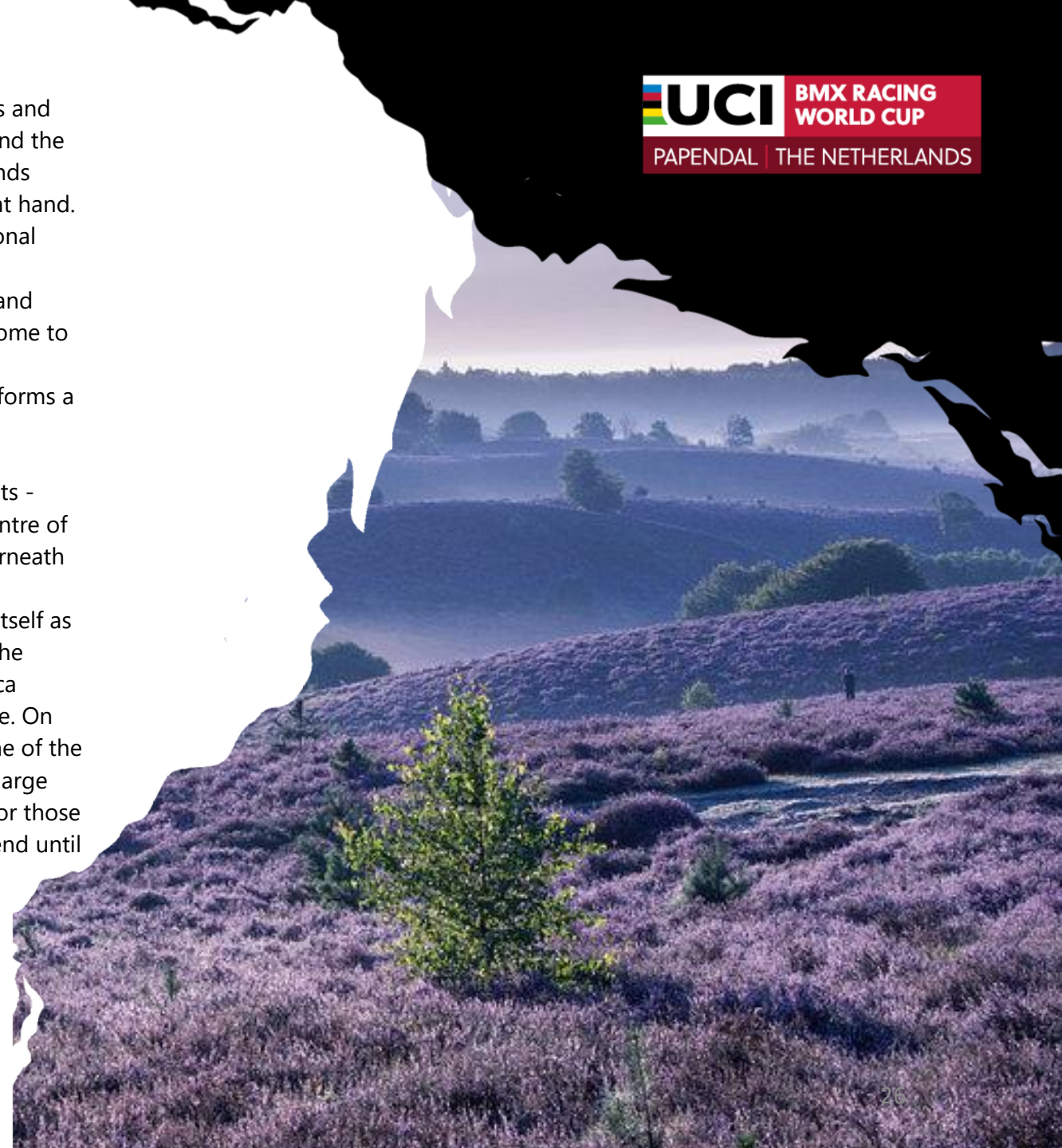
About Arnhem & Gelderland



Arnhem is situated in the province of Gelderland, famous for its wonderful forests and cultural habitats. For style and culture, visit Arnhem and the province. Here you find the famous Kröller-Müller Museum with its extensive sculpture garden. The Netherlands Open Air Museum, the famous Ouwehands Zoo and Burgers' Zoo are also close at hand.
